


THE OLYMPIC EXPERIENCE

The Olympic Museum restaurant.

Inviting and warm, and overlooking Lake Geneva, the TOM Café has a panoramic terrace with a breathtaking view. It is open for Museum visitors during the day and can be hired privately for evening functions.

GALLERY AND TERRACE

A place of culture for your aperitifs and cocktails.

Next to the TOM Café, the Gallery is a temporary exhibition zone that can be hired privately. In the warm season, the Gallery opens into a terrace with a panoramic view of the lake and the Alps. An entrance provides direct access to the Gallery from the outside, without entering The Museum; as well as the Terrace.

COUBERTIN CLUB

A light and bright place ideal for cocktails, meals or gala evenings.

The Coubertin Club pays tribute to the founder of the International Olympic Committee and reviver of the Games: Baron Pierre de Coubertin. The Club, with its modern and elegant design, can be divided into two sections. Situated next to the TOM Café, it benefits from an exceptional view and has access to the terrace.








