INTRODUCTION

The Games of the XXVIII Olympiad in Athens were not only a great success in terms of their organization and the huge numbers of people that either turned up to see them or watched them on television, but also due to the highest figures yet for women's involvement.

As if to pay tribute to the IOC's gender promotion policies, three of the leading figures in the organization of the Games were women. The embodiment of that Greek success was none other than the President of Athens Organizing Committee (ATHOC), Mrs. Gianna Angelopoulos-Daskalaki.

The Mayor of the City of Athens was Mrs Dora Bakoyannis while the person who took over as minister of culture in the days leading up to the Games was Mrs. Fanny Petralia.

Thus, in more ways than one, the Games were a celebration of women's participation in sport. They won more medals than ever before. There were more women in these Games than at any other previous Olympic Games. More women were in charge of teams as chefs de mission and three of them were there as President of their NOC. The number of women flag bearers also rose significantly.

Wrestling contributed to this celebration by scoring its own first. About time too! Women participated in various freestyle events in Athens finally putting to rest suggestions that the public was not interested in seeing women athletes competing in one of the oldest sports. And the public seemed to like it, thus guaranteeing its inclusion in future programmes.

The significant gains attained by women on the field also had a lot to do with NOCs taking advantage of Olympic Solidarity programmes. Women athletes, and men, who have benefited from Olympic Solidarity's talent identification and scholarship programmes, have tended to improve their performances. The women administrators and chefs de mission have also benefited, in one way or the other, from the programmes.

The results of the IOC's gender promotion policy and the positive response of International Federations and NOCs, had much to do with the swelling numbers of women participants in the Games both as competitors and administrators. The IOC may have put brakes on the expansion of the Games programme, but innovative measures have enabled International Federations to increase the number women participants while at the same time enhancing the quality of their programmes.

Athens was certainly the turning in women's participation in the Olympic Games. It can only be better next time around. The IOC Women and Sport Commission is stepping up its efforts, with the assistance of Olympic Solidarity, to help women acquire the necessary knowledge to empower themselves by organizing special educational seminars in different parts of the world. The Commission will this year run special seminars with NOCs and IOC partner organizations to help women in sports management and sports journalism.

The numbers and statistics in this document give an impressive overview of the current situation, reflecting an encouraging result of the hard work carried out by women themselves. It provides comforting assurance that given the opportunity women can perform any sporting task in the Olympic Movement. The appointment of Nawal El-Moutawakel as the first-ever woman chairperson of an Evaluation Commission by the President of the IOC, Dr. Jacques Rogge is a case in point.

The toughest of the goals is one that seems the least difficult: to ensure that every participating NOC in the Games in Beijing has a woman in its ranks.

1 OLYMPIC PROGRAMME EVOLUTION

1.2 Programme in Athens

Women competed in 26 of the 28 sports events (92.8% of sports events, including mixed ones). Women were represented in the same amount of team sports as men.¹

Women's sport in the Olympic Programme in Athens did not face important changes, while in Sydney, programme changes for women's sports and events were more important.

In Sydney, four additional sports, one discipline, 24 events were added and 7 events were modified allowing women's participation.

1.3 Wrestling

Wrestling is present in the Olympic programme since 1896 with the Greco-roman and since 1904 with freestyle for male athletes. Female wrestling has been recognized by FILA in 1983. It was in 2001 that the IOC announced the introduction of wrestling for women in



the Olympic programme. Even though the trend showed a general wish to maintain the same Olympic programme in terms of sports and events, gender equality arguments were finally the determining factor and led to the inclusion of this new sport for women.

2 GENDER REPRESENTATION

2.2 National Olympic Committee (NOC) Delegations

201 NOC delegations participated to the Olympic Games (except Djibouti)². Out of these:

- 9 NOCs had no woman: British Virgin Islands, Netherlands Antilles, Brunei Darussalam, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Yemen, Liechtenstein.

Some of the same NOCs also did not have women in their delegations in Sydney: British Virgin Islands, Brunei Darussalam, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates.

- 2 NOCs had no men in their delegations: Chad, Myanmar
- Additional NOCs with mixed delegations: Botswana (1 woman/10 men), Liberia (6/2), Kuwait (1/10).

These delegations had no women at the 2000 Sydney Olympiads.





There is a decrease of 21% of Olympic Scholarships women athletes holders who won medals in comparison with Sydney 2000, where 28 medals were won by Olympic Scholarship women athletes' holders. However, 25 National Olympic Committees represented 57 athletes who won medals, which ratio is similar to Sydney, where 29 NOCs represented their 61 Olympic Scholarships holders who won medals.



Increase of 20% of Olympic Scholarships holders who won diplomas in comparison with Sydney 2000, where 84 diplomas were won by Olympic Scholarship athletes' holders from the "Sydney 2000" programme.

These 105 athletes who won diplomas represent 47 NOCs, which is an increase of 30% in comparison with Sydney, which had 33 NOCs representing their 84 winners.
