

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE OLYMPIC CHARTER

Marked up to current version of the Olympic Charter

1. Proposed amendment to Rule 16.3.3.2.2

Rule 16 3.3.2 Extension of age limit:

3.3.2.2 There may be no more than five-ten such IOC members for whom the age limit is extended at any time.

2. Proposed amendment to Bye-law to Rule 16.3

Bye-law to Rule 16 Register of members

3. The IOC Executive Board keeps an up-to-date register of all the IOC members, Honorary President, honorary members and honour members. Those suspended, if any, are listed separately. The register specifies the origin of each member's candidature and indicates whether the member's candidature was submitted as an active athlete, or linked to another function, or submitted as an independent individual.

3. Proposed amendment to Rule 18.3

Rule 18 The Session

The quorum required for a Session is half the total membership of the IOC with voting rights plus one. Decisions of the Session are taken by a majority of the votes cast; however, a majority of two-thirds of the votes cast is required for any modification of the Fundamental Principles of Olympism, of the Rules of the Olympic Charter, or if elsewhere provided in the Olympic Charter.

4. Proposed amendment to Bye-Law to Rule 45.1.3.1

5. Proposed amendment to Bye-law to Rule 46.4.2

Bye-law to Rule 46

4.2 Subject to the approval of the IOC Executive Board, the OCOG shall provide the IFs, at their request and at their expense, with the administrative and technical facilities, as well as accommodation, if available, enabling them to hold their meetings in the country of the host host country.

6. Proposed amendment to Rule 54

Rule 54 Use of the Olympic flame

 The OCOG is responsible for bringing the Olympic flame to the opening ceremony venue Olympic stadium. All arrangements for any torch relay and any use of the Olympic flame shall be carried out in compliance with the IOC Protocol Guide and other protocol-related requirements set forth in the Olympic Host Contract.
