Good Governance

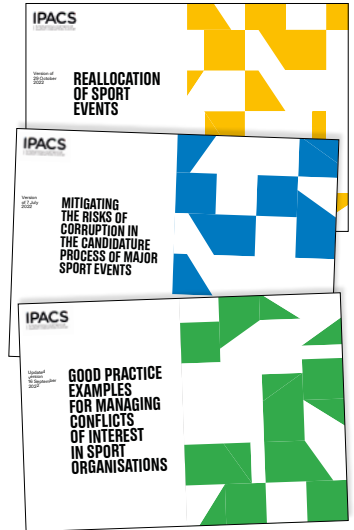
Good governance principles to mitigate the risk of corruption.
